It will have a few portions that you can study for (Vocabulary, Phrases, Plots from stories) and it will have a portion that is a measure of your overall skills (apart from recalling information). This second portion will not really be something that you can "study for"-so just focus on the first part. The exam will take portions from any/all of the following topics that we have covered. Please note that the GRAMMAR PACKET that you have DOES NOT have all of the information that will be on the final exam. This list provides you with all of the elements that will be on the exam.
